Targeted Support in Mathematics

What does targeted support in mathematics involve?

Every Maths Hub in England offers targeted support to eligible primary and secondary schools in the hub area. It involves enabling schools to develop approaches to teaching for mastery through support for the school's leadership and teachers of maths.

Enhanced support is for schools participating in standard Teaching for Mastery Programmes. The support is tailored to address specific barriers to implementation that school leaders identify.

Intensive support involves sustained, bespoke collaboration with leaders to develop a school's capacity and climate for implementation. In the long term, this aims to build the foundations for accessing the standard Teaching for Mastery Programmes.

- School leaders will confidently assess and review the culture, systems and practices supporting maths in their school
- School leaders will foster an implementation climate that supports improvements to teaching and learning in maths
- Your school will go on to develop a sustained relationship with your local Maths Hub
