

Work Groups are led by a teacher, or former teacher, who has expertise in maths education and leading professional development – also known as an LLME (local leader of maths education)




Work Group participants meet regularly during the year to collaborate with peers from other local schools, to share ideas and develop their own practice



Between sessions, participants try things out in their own classrooms then meet back in the Work Group to share experiences and next steps

Each Work Group is normally part of a Network Collaborative Project (NCP)
